Preparation

- 1. Go to boardgamearena.
- 2. Select *simple game, real time* speed and *play with friends.*
- 3. Add all other players using the username they registered with on the platform.
- 4. Select the game:



5. Click *start the game*

Remember

• When the conditions to get an aim are achieved, the platform doesn't recognize it automatically. The player has to click the *aim card* so that it appears as achieved.

Development of the game

Aim: To get the highest number of victory points. Those points are reflected in the *goal cards*.




Turn. The game is developed by turns, in the clockwise. During each turn, there are two phases:

 Throw the weather dice. It is thrown from the second round at the start of each player's turn. The platform throws it automatucally. When the mouse is moved on the weather, it indicates the applicable effect.



2) To make **actions** and to complete the **objectives**.

You have to make 2 different actions between the possible 5.



Take an irrigation canal: it carries the water from the initial plot to those which aren't in touch with the initial one to achieve plot aim o to make the bamboo to grow up.

To move the *gardener* to a plot. If this one receives water, the bamboo will grow up one level (until the maximum of 4 levels).

Move the *Panda* and eat a bamboo section.

Take a new objective card. You can't have more than 5. There are 3 kinds: *plot, gardener and Panda*.

End of the game

- Depending of there are playing 2, 3 or 4 players, the game Will finish whrn a player gets 9, 8 or 7 goals respectively.
- Tha first player in achieving the number of specific number of goals Will receive the card *emperor*, which gives 2 extra victory points. This one will be the last round. Esa será la última ronda
- Tha player with more victory points Will be the winner.
